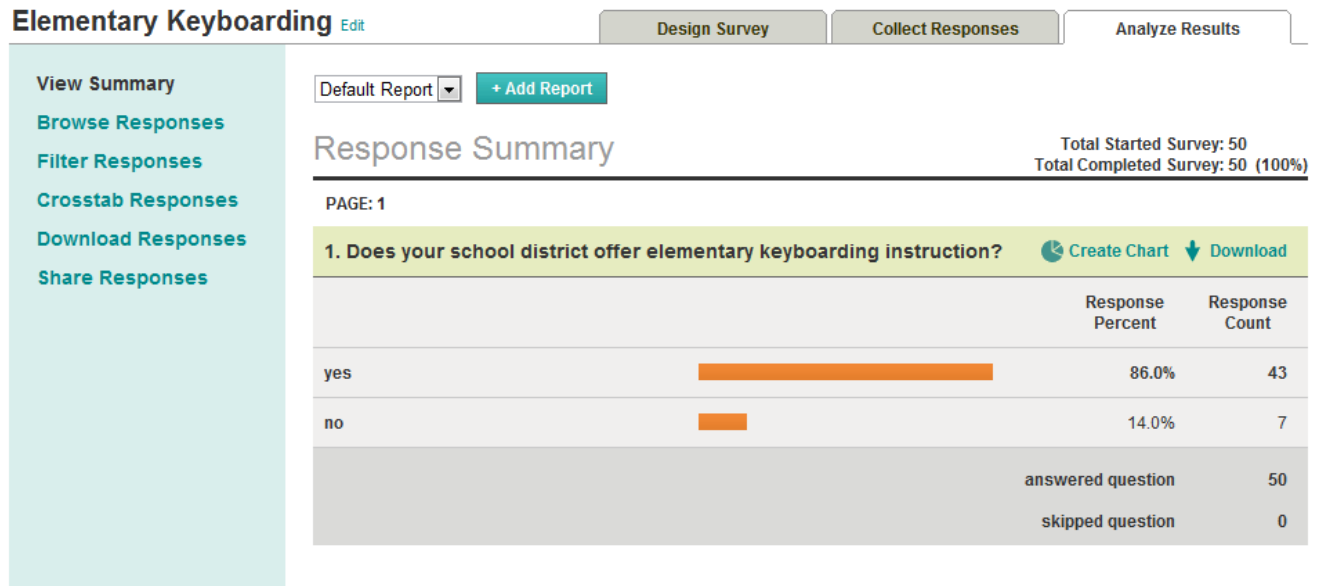


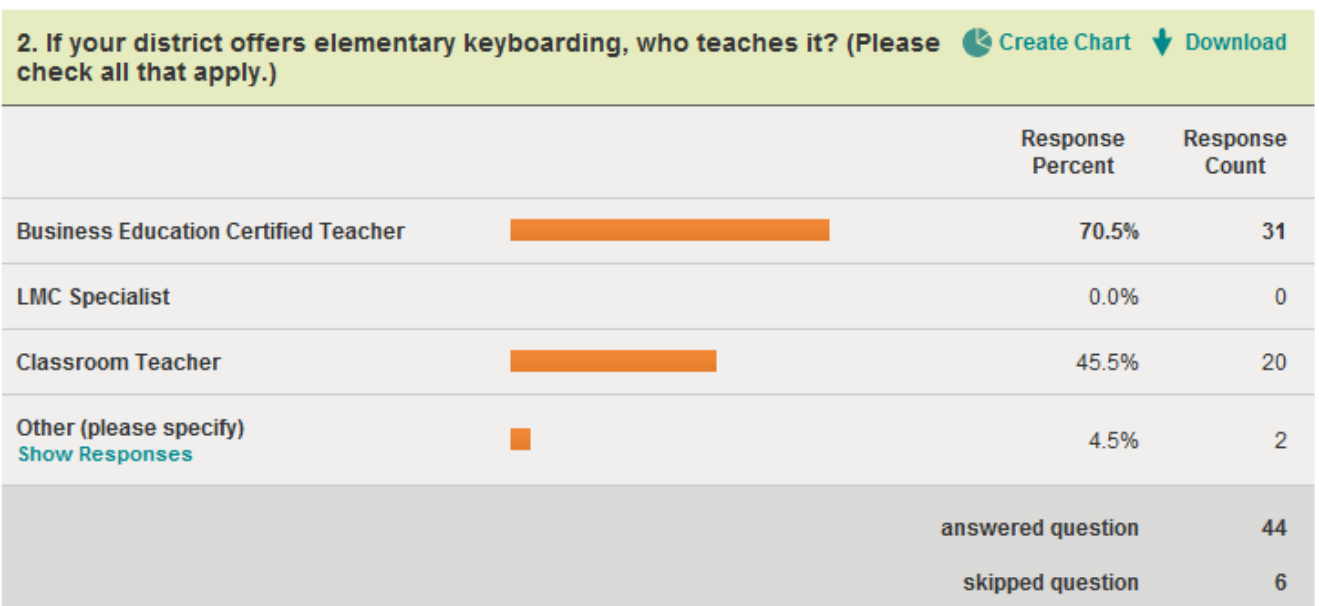
Elementary Keyboarding Survey Results

In response to your request, I put an informal survey request out to the Business Education List Serve to determine which districts have elementary keyboarding, which teachers or certifications teach it, and in which grades elementary keyboarding is taught. The survey was live for almost one week. Fifty teachers from various districts throughout Wisconsin began and completed the survey.

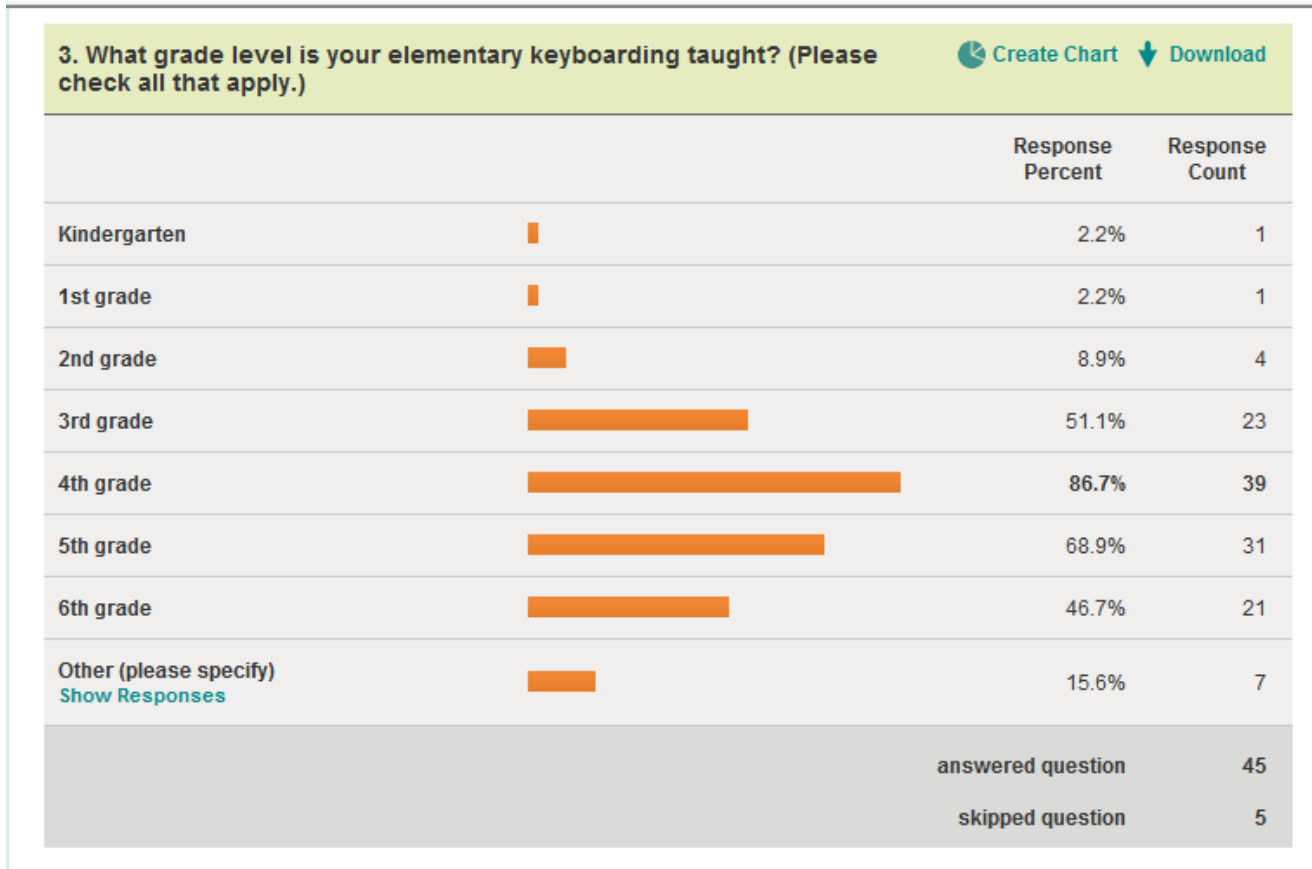
Of the respondents, 86% had keyboarding taught at the elementary level in the teacher's district.



When asked about who teaches elementary keyboarding, over 70% of the respondents' districts had elementary keyboarding taught by Business Education Certified Teachers. We believe this is because the students learn the proper technique and skills of touch typing from teachers that have taken methods courses in teaching keyboarding as well experience with student teaching in keyboarding.



Instruction in keyboarding varied from kindergarten through 6th grade but was primarily taught at the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade levels.
